

One Pager Assignment & Rubric

A “One-Pager*” is a written and graphic interpretation of what you have read presented on a single sheet of paper. The idea/concept behind the One Pager is similar to “sketch noting” as it is meant to help you visualize what you’ve read. (**If you google image search “one pagers” you’ll see several examples*)

Guidelines:

- Use standard (8 ½ by 11) unlined paper (computer/printer paper)- You may go up to “legal size,” but no larger. You may also use the Google Templates.
- Fill the entire page!
- Written work must be neat & legible
- Use color and demonstrate creativity for images/illustrations – no pencil please!
- Include all of the following elements (the arrangement is your choice):
 - A border which somehow represents the key themes or motif from what you have read.
 - Images with quotations woven into or around them (at least three). The images should somehow represent what you consider to be the most important symbols in the text.
 - Images and/or doodled words that represent the key characters from the text and how they developed over the course of the text.
 - Images and quotations that show the author’s style of writing, and the power of the figurative devices that are used.
 - Images and/or words that show connections between the themes and ideas in the writing and what is going on in the world today (*and or how we’ve evolved (or haven’t) based on the setting of the play/novel*) (*Sophistication point work here.*)
 - Three important quotations from across the text with proper citations
 - Words and/or images that show the significance of the setting in some way

Analysis <i>15 points</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● It is clear from the arrangement of your evidence & images that your analysis is through & succinct; demonstrates advanced thinking 	
Quotations <i>15 points</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Textual evidence represents the work as a whole (they span several portions of the play/novel); Textual evidence is particularly powerful or connected in an insightful manner; Quotations are cited properly (MLA). 	
Graphics & Required Elements <i>20 points</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All components of the assignment are visible on one-page; Graphic elements are well-chosen and well executed; required elements are incorporated seamlessly into the artwork
