## PLAN

1. Read the introduction to the question.
2. Answer the Constructed Response Questions (Part A) in complete sentences.
3. Create a graphic organizer:

<i>Thesis statement</i>	
<i>Note: draw the number of boxes equal to the number of questions/tasks.</i>	
<i>Conclusion</i>	

4. Place the name of the documents in the appropriate box.
5. In each box, jot down at least two key facts (and analysis) in each box that go with each document.
- ★ 6. Add your star, your outside fact(s).
7. Use your task to write your thesis statement.
8. Restate your thesis as your conclusion.



## WRITE your essay. Be sure to include:

1. Write the introduction. Use the historical context of the question to help you.
2. Write body paragraphs. Rule of thumb is that you have one paragraph for each question/task.
3. State the documents you are referring to.
4. Remember to include a detailed analysis.
5. Make a strong conclusion that restates the thesis and summarizes the theme or problem
