



WANTED POSTER



Having carefully read Machiavelli's *The Prince*, you are now ready to look for the ideal leader. Think long and hard and use everything you know about *successful* leaders to decide the one person that you think best embodies Machiavelli's ideas. Please do not approach this determination superficially. To be blunt, Hitler would NOT represent Machiavelli's ideal.

Create a wanted poster representing that ideal leader. Your poster should follow the format of a standard wanted poster. Your wanted poster MUST include the following information (some information may be fabricated for the purpose of the assignment, but the bulk must be rooted in fact):

1. Personal Image
2. Full Name + any Aliases
3. Biographical Info (date of birth, position/job, place of birth)
4. Physical Description (height, weight, eye/hair color, identifying marks, clothing, etc.)
5. Wanted for. Write at least 5 reasons in complete sentences, why your chosen person is "wanted." Use specific facts about leadership, actions, etc.
6. Appropriate symbols (American flag, mandela, etc.)
7. Who is looking for him/her
8. Last Seen
9. Reward
10. Bibliography (Can be on back of poster).
